He finished residency training in cardiology at the Veterinary Referral Center, Little Falls, New Jersey, and the Ryan Veterinary Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania, Philadelphia. His areas of interest include hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, therapy of heart failure, diastolic dysfunction, and electrophysiology. Dr. Herndon is a board certified cardiologist and provides full service cardiovascular diagnostics and therapeutics – including surgical implantation of long term arrhythmia detection devices, transvenous pacemaker implantation, balloon valvuloplasty, percutaneous balloon pericardiotomy, and patent ductus arteriosus coil embolization. He is a featured consultant in cardiology on the Veterinary Information Network (VIN) and conducts clinical research to develop blood tests for dogs and cats that may aid in the diagnosis and treatment of heart disease. He was a cardiologist in the Washington DC area before joining California Veterinary Specialists in San Marcos (San Diego County), California.
